FACEBOOK GRANTS:

Full details are not yet available, but Facebook has committed offering \$100M in cash grants and ad credits for up to 30,000 eligible small businesses. Businesses can sign up for notifications [here.](#)

YELP:

relief for restaurants and bars impacted by coronavirus: Yelp is offering \$25 million in relief to restaurants and bars affected by Coronavirus. Program benefits include:

- Waiving charges for Yelp Ads in the second half of March for restaurants and bars with active ad campaigns
- Free \$100 ad campaign to restaurants that indicate they offer delivery or take-out in the month of April (current advertisers only, must set up by March 31)
- Ad campaigns are automatically being paused for the month of April (unless you request otherwise)
- The business highlights, call to action, and yelp connect features will be offered free of charge through March and April for all bars and restaurants (requires setup)
- Yelp Reservations and Yelp Waitlist are both free for 3 months
